- Mandated reporting in CCC's Health Services?

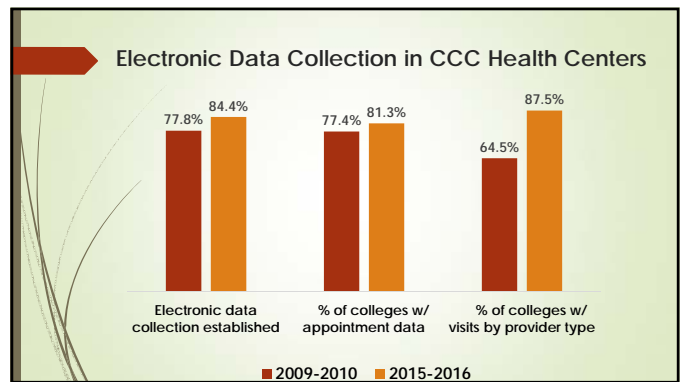

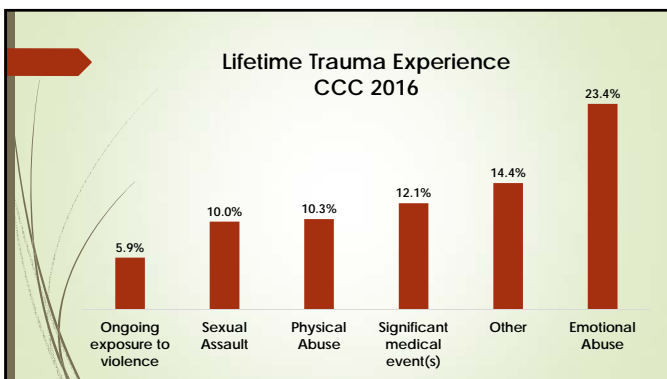
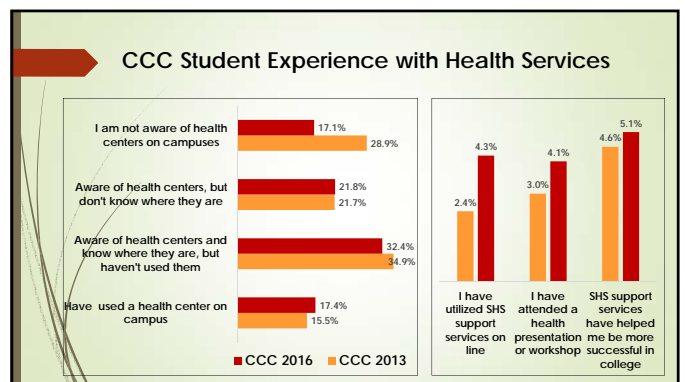
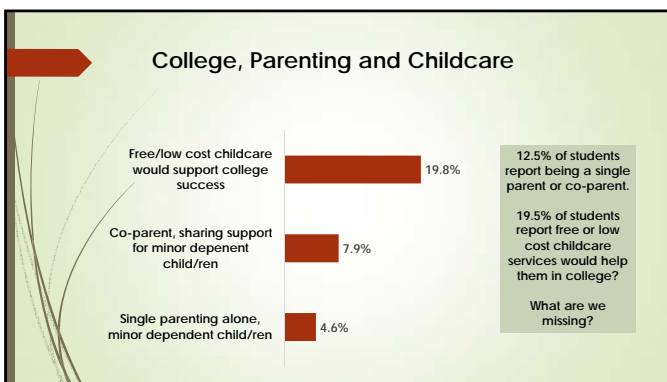
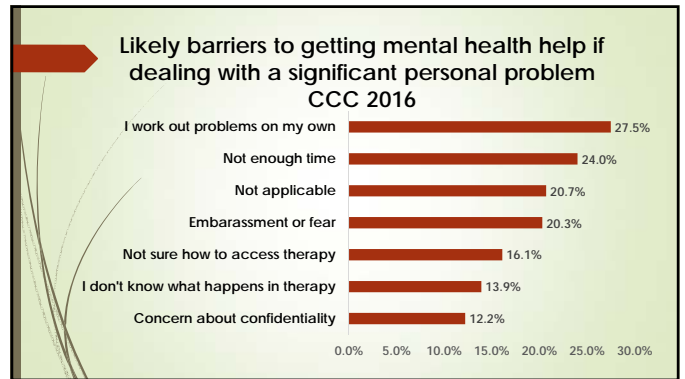
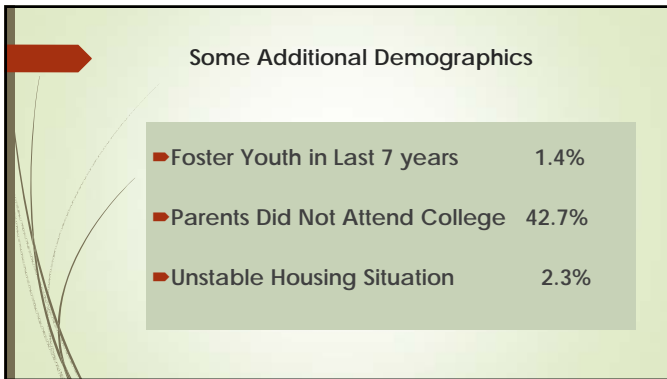


### Reference Groups

- ACHA-NCHA II Reference Data Spring 16 is called **ACHA or ACHA 2016** representing National Data N: 80,139
- CCC - Reference Group Data Spring '16 is called **CCC-RG or CCC-RG 2016**. This data is used when comparing with national data, ACHA 2016 N: 7,378
- California Community Colleges Data Spring '16 is called **CCC or CCC 2016**, NOT used in comparing with data, but is used when comparing with CCC 2013 data N: 12,931
- All California Community Colleges Data Spring '13 is called **CCC 2013** and used to show changes in the CCC population. N: 17,271
- Supplemental Survey data is being pulled from **CCC 2016**

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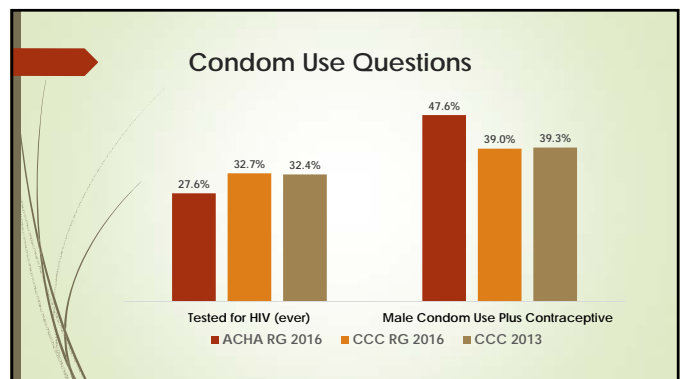
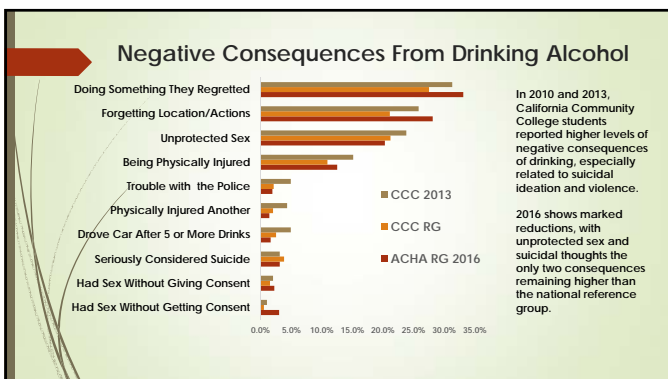
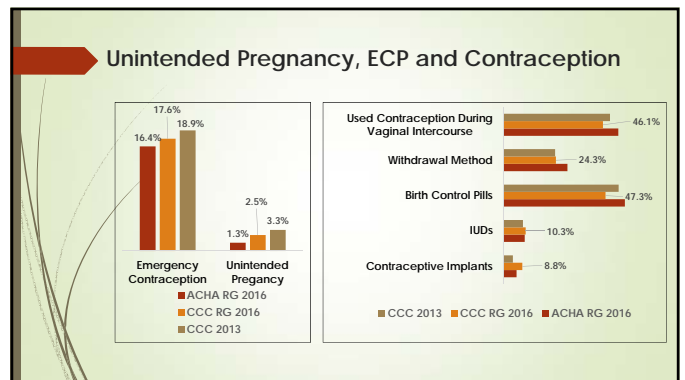
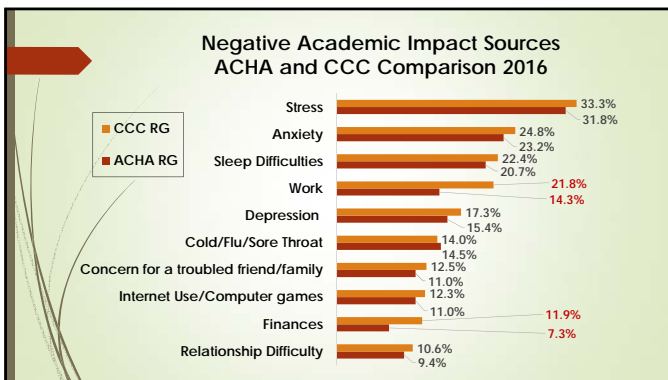
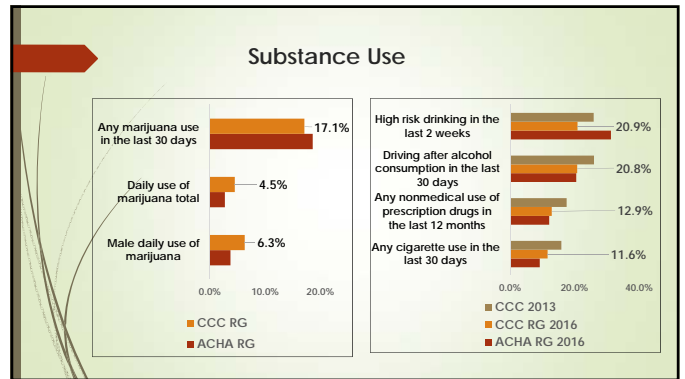
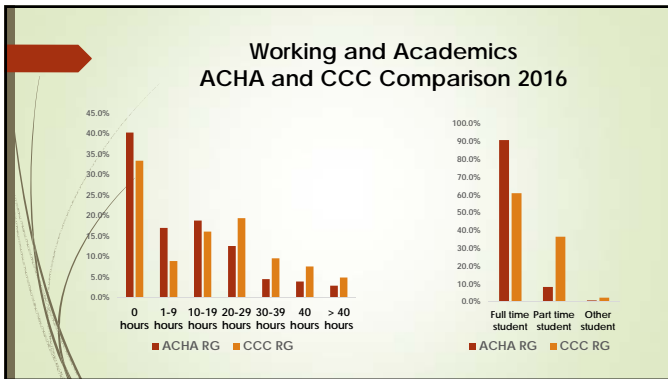
