## California Legislation

- SB 276 was signed by the Governor October 8, 2015.
- Allows same LEA Medi-Cal billing option for Community Colleges that K-12 school districts have had for 23 years.
- Special thanks to the efforts of Sally Bratton and Sang Leng Trieu for working with our legislation to ensure California Community College Student Health Service/Centers could participate.





## Medi-Cal Local Educational Agency (LEA) option

- The Local Educational Agency (LEA) Medi-Cal Billing Option Program provides the federal share of reimbursement for health assessment and treatment for Medi-Cal eligible participants within the school environment. A LEA provider (generally a school district or county office of education, and now community colleges) employs or contracts with qualified medical practitioners to render certain health services.



## Opportunities for LEA Restricted Fund Spending

- 1. Health Care, including**
  - Immunizations
  - Vision and hearing testing services
  - Dental Services
  - Physical examinations, diagnostic, and referrals services
  - Prenatal Care
- 2. Mental Health Services, including**
  - Primary prevention
  - Crisis intervention
  - Assessments and referrals
  - Training for faculty in detection of mental health problems
- 3. Substance Abuse prevention and treatment services**



## Why Participate?

- Federal funding available for providing direct medical services.
- Reinvest funds in health services – these are *restricted funds that can ONLY be spent on health/mental health services*.
- Ease budget constraints by reimbursing colleges for the cost of providing services.



## Opportunities for LEA Restricted Fund Spending

- 4. Family Support and parenting education**
  - Child abuse prevention
  - Parenting programs
- 5. Academic support services**
  - Tutoring
  - Mentoring
  - Employment
  - Community service internships
  - In-Service training for faculty and administrators
- 6. Counseling**
  - Family counseling
  - Suicide prevention



## LEA Provider Responsibilities

- Comply with Welfare & Institution Code.
- Retain records for a minimum of three years from date of submission.
- Ensure all Medi-Cal covered services are provided by a qualified practitioner.
- Ensure that all Medi-Cal beneficiaries are aware of freedom of choice.
- Ensure services are billed using the National Provider Identification (NPI) number.
- Reinvest federal funds received from LEA services into new services, not supplant existing services.


